Credit will be issued for **TREK 151/ TREK 153** when I have successfully completed all of the requirements.
- VII. I further understand that any Service-Learning clock-hours I have contributed to **TREK 151/ TREK 153** in one semester may not be carried over should I be unable to complete all the required community based learning hours.
